



KidQuest Childcare Information

HealthQuest is pleased to provide three on-site childcare areas located within our club. Our childcare areas host a fun, safe environment for your child to play and interact with other children. HealthQuest childcare workers are First Aid and CPR-certified, and exceed the standard requirements in order to care for our youngest members.

KidQuest

This childcare area entertains our youngest members. Children ages six weeks to six years must be registered with a wristband while parents utilize the Club. Age-appropriate toys, arts and crafts, games, dress-up, and music are just a few of the activities in which your children can participate.

JrQuest

A separate area attached to KidQuest provides children ages 4-6 the opportunity to interact with their peers in a quieter setting, away from younger children. Children in JrQuest must be registered with KidQuest prior to entering JrQuest. Children ages 4-6 have the option to move freely between KidQuest and JrQuest.

CyberQuest

Children ages 7-12 must register in this area, located in the Sports Center. Children must also be registered with a wristband while parents utilize the Club. Activities include group fitness classes, free play, organized sports, homework time, and Wii fitness games.

Childcare Rules

- Children must be at least six weeks of age.
- Childcare is limited to a 2-hour maximum, with a 15-minute grace period.
- Parents must remain in the Club while children are registered in childcare areas.
- Only children of members, their registered guests, and HealthQuest staff are permitted in KidQuest.
- Parents are required to sign the "Parent Location" form when registering their child.
- Children with visible signs of illness will not be permitted to enter KidQuest. These symptoms include, but are not limited to: runny nose with yellow or green mucus, rashes (until diagnosed), conjunctivitis (pink eye), or a "wet" cough. Admittance is based upon the discretion of the KidQuest staff.
- Due to food allergies, no outside food or beverage is permitted in KidQuest.
- Staff is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal items.
- Items (such as toys) small enough to be ingested by young children will not be permitted in KidQuest.
- Staff does not change diapers or bottle-feed young children. Parents will be paged and must return to KidQuest to attend to their child.
- Staff will utilize verbal discipline, should behavioral issues arise. If necessary, "time-out" will be administered, and the parents notified.
- Biting is not tolerated. To ensure the safety of everyone, any child who bites three times will be barred from KidQuest until it is understood that biting is unacceptable.

Check-In Procedure

Our check-in area provides an easy way to check your child in prior to your workout. Each child registered will be given a wristband with his or her name, their check-in time, and the last three digits of the parents' scan card (for security purposes). Parents using Transportation must also know the location and time of their child's class(es).

Checking Out

When checking out of any childcare areas, parents must either give the attendant the final three digits of their scan card (written on their child's wristband) verbally, or present the card itself. Please wait for a childcare staff member to retrieve your child. Please **do not** open the door, or lift your child over it.

Transportation

Transportation allows parents to enjoy their workout without the worry of getting children to and from scheduled youth programs. Transportation is provided to Dance, Gymnastics, Martial Arts, Soccer and Basketball.

Transportation Rules

- Parents must allow themselves enough time to sign children into the childcare areas.
- If applicable, please know your child's class location and time.
- Members arriving late and missing Transportation will be responsible for taking their child to class, as well as picking them up.
- Parents will not be given wristbands in order to have their child brought back from class. All children transported to a class must return to the childcare area before checking out. Barring emergencies, no child should be checked directly out of class.
- KidQuest staff should be made aware anytime a child checks out of KidQuest prior to using Transportation (should they be registered for it). Children's names must be removed from the Transportation list, saving time and worry in looking for children who have already been checked out.

A Note to Our Guests:

All guests are required to stop at the Front Desk prior to entering the Club. Guests must be accompanied by a member and pay the \$10.00 guest fee when registering. Guests are required to bring their paid receipt to KidQuest when checking children in.

KidQuest Happy Day Camp

A fee-based program, Happy Day Camp provides members the opportunity to leave the Club for a three-hour time period to run errands, enjoy lunch with a friend, or simply have some "alone time" away from the Club. Happy Day Camp is available Monday through Friday, from 8 AM to 8 PM. Happy Day Camp can be used by a non-member when accompanied by a member. Members should call ahead to register their child. Children must be at least one year of age.

Rates

Member rates apply to Family Membership or Parent/Child Membership.

One Child:	\$7.00 per hour
Two Children:	\$10.00 per hour
Three or More Children:	\$12.00 per hour

Non-Member rates apply to an Individual Membership and friends of a member.

Per Child:	\$9.00 per hour
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Happy Day Camp Rules

- Children must all be of the same family.
- Parents must leave a cell phone contact number.
- Please leave diapers, wipes, and a change of clothing for all children (6-year-olds can have accidents or become ill as easily as young children).
- Snacks are permitted in a designated area away from other children.
- Parents are responsible for children's snacks and/or lunches. **Due to the persistent risk of food allergies, no peanut products will be permitted!**
- Personal items such as diaper bags and Sippy Cups should be labeled with your child's name

Kidz Night Out Program

A party every Saturday night! Each month, members with a family membership or a parent/couple membership can take advantage of a **free** night out! You choose! Each week is themed with fun and exciting things to do! Dinner, sports, crafts, and movies; all while hanging with your friends! Great things for the kids to do while Mom and Dad enjoy a night out. Kidz Night Out is also available to non-members as a fee-based program.

On a Saturday night, Kidz Night Out is home away from home! Go out, have a great time, and leave the kids with us!

Kidz Night Out Policies and Procedures

- Registration is done online, beginning Sunday and ending at 11:00 PM Thursday evening.
- A **\$25.00 late fee per family** is applied to all members registering after 11:00 PM on Thursday. All phone messages left after 6:00 PM on Thursday are also subject to the late fee. Please understand, members are given a *five-day window* to register for Kidz Night Out.
- Attempting to register online or calling the Program Desk after the 6:00 PM Thursday does not exempt a member from paying a late fee.
- All voice messages received on Friday morning, along with Saturday night walk-ins will be charged a late fee.

- Registering your child for dinner does not automatically enroll your child in Kidz Night Out; registering is a *two-step process*. Please review your confirmation to be sure your child is registered correctly.
- Staff is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal items.
- Children presenting behavioral issues will be brought to KidQuest and remain there, accompanied by staff, until picked up by parents.
- Unused Kidz Night Out registrations are non-transferrable month-to-month.
- Members will not be credited for dinner, should they cancel, or for other reasons not attend.

Kidz Night Out Prices

Dinner:

\$5.00 per child.

Pizza, unless otherwise noted, is optional for children 3-12 years of age. Snacks and juice boxes are always available.

Occasional specialty crafts and activities:

\$5.00 per child.

Before-Care:

5:30-6:30 PM; \$10.00 per child. These prices apply to all participants in Kidz Night Out.
